

Royal Oudenaarde is the "International Champion 2023" after winning against GC Sluispolder from the Netherlands.



The GolfSixes League aims to introduce the game of golf for children up to 13 years of age in a more social way by approaching it in a different way ... the "scramble" formula allows the children to be part of a team in a structured environment ... but without the pressure that an individual golf match brings.

This year, 10 (Flemish) clubs entered three different "Leagues." In spring, qualifiers were played locally that each had a regional champion: GC Hasselt (Limburg), GC Beveren (West Flanders) and Royal Oudenaarde (East Flanders).

On September 23, the champions had to decide among themselves who would become national champion. It became an exciting day on the Executive Course of Ternesse GCC and in the end it was Royal Oudenaarde that walked away with the win. Meanwhile, in the Netherlands, GC Sluispolder

became national champion and a traditional meet was scheduled for October 15. This time the match could take place on the Championship Course which was shortened a bit. Royal Oudenaarde took control immediately by winning a couple of holes in the first two matches. Even the intense rain, which stopped play for an hour, could not get them out of their "zone". Sluispolder won the last match showing heart to fight until the end.
